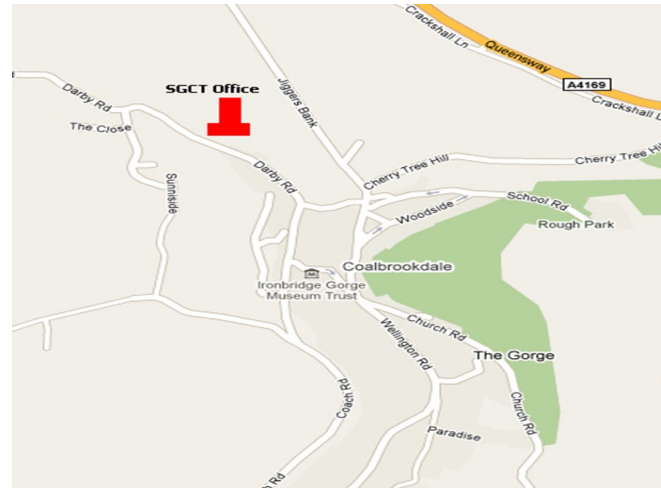


Get Involved!
