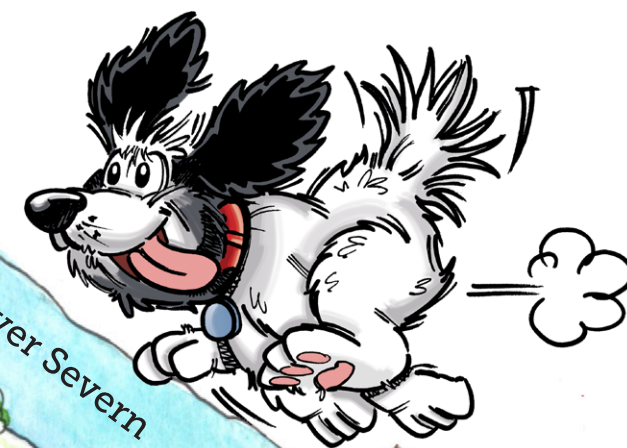


Limekiln
